

The use, by individuals or organizations, of the Library's facilities for displays and/or exhibits, other than those which pertain to the library, is a privilege which is subject to review by the Board of Trustees.

- A bulletin board and brochure bins are available for announcements of fine art events, civic programs, city and government job openings, educational opportunities and general interest brochures. A PUBLIC DISPLAY BULLETIN BOARD HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR THE PUBLIC. THESE ITEMS MAY BE DISPLAYED FOR UP TO 30 DAYS, OR UNTIL THE PROGRAM DATE IF LESS THAN 30 DAYS.
- The library director must approve placing posters, displays, exhibits, pamphlets, brochures or leaflets. (within the library)
- The library assumes no responsibility for the preservation, protection, or possible damage or theft of any item displayed or exhibited. All items placed on library premises are done so at the owner's risk.

It is the policy of the Grimes Public Library to post criminal notices received or verified from the Department of Criminal Investigation, or received from the Polk County Sheriff's Office. If a private citizen requests that a criminal notice be posted at the library, the library will verify the information contained with the notice with the appropriate criminal agency to verify that it is an official document. The length of time in which this document is posted will be governed by other policies adopted by the Grimes Public Library.
