

12. GRIMES PUBLIC LIBRARY DISPLAY POLICY

The use, by individuals or organizations, of the Library's facilities for displays and/or exhibits, other than those which pertain to the library, is a privilege which is subject to review by the Board of Trustees.

A bulletin board and brochure bins are available for announcements of fine art events, civic programs, public notices, city and government job openings, educational opportunities and general interest brochures. Posters announcing bazaars or programs sponsored by any local, educational, religious or fraternal organization will be permitted provided there is room for such displays and they are of reasonable size.

The library director or his/her designee must approve placing posters, displays, exhibits, pamphlets, brochures or leaflets. Displays shall be on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be discarded in 30 days, or when event date has passed, by library staff.

No organization or individual shall be permitted to place in the library, any box, receptacle or canister which solicits monetary donations.

No poster or display will be permitted which advocates or solicits consideration of any product or service sold by any commercial enterprise. Political announcements are not allowed.

The library assumes no responsibility for the preservation, protection, or possible damage or theft of any item displayed or exhibited. All items placed in the library are done so at the owner's risk.
